With the dedicated support of Toot ‘n Totum for the last 11 years, the Amarillo Education Foundation has awarded a \$10,000 bank card to a lucky Panhandle winner. This year’s winner, chosen from five semi-finalists, is Coral Allen. Ms. Allen selected the winning key that opened the treasure chest with the \$10,000 bank card. The other four semi-finalists discovered a \$100 bank credit card in the bottom of the chest their selected key opened.

The finalist event took place at the culmination of the Amarillo Independent School District Partners in Education dinner at the Civic Center. Ms. Allen was the first name drawn in the semi-final drawing, therefore giving her the honor of drawing the first key. And, that good fortune gave her the \$10,000,
